## **University of Memphis Language Fair 2020**

## GUIDELINES

- Students will submit a project based on particular countries and/or cultures in the target language. Projects must
  display effort on the part of students to present research on, and an understanding of, some aspect of a foreign
  country or culture.
- Each research project must include a 3x5 card with the following information:
  - o Category: RESEARCH PROJECT
  - Language
  - School
  - Name of student(s)
  - Name of teacher
- Projects should not exceed an area of 3 feet by 4 feet.
- Projects that have won prizes in previous years may not be re-submitted.
- Maximum of two entries per class and two students per project.
- Foreign language students, native/heritage speakers, and speakers of cognate languages are welcome to participate in this event.
- All display events (Art, Crafts, Greeting Cards, Posters, and Research Projects) must be in the appropriate room (organized by language) by 8:45 a.m. on the day of the Fair. They must also be retrieved from the rooms where they are displayed by 2:00 p.m. or they will be thrown away.
