Japanese Major

 A Major in World Language (Japanese concentration) consists of 24 credit hours (eight courses) at the upperdivision level (3000 level or above).

- There are three possible concentrations:
 - concentration in Japanese
 - a two-language concentration, combining Japanese with one other language taught in the department*
 - a three-language concentration: Japanese and two other languages taught in the department**

To declare Japanese Major, please go to Scates Room 107.

*A two-language concentration chosen from Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish: 27 upper division semester hours with a minimum of 9 semester hours in each language.

**A three-language concentration chosen from Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish: All three language concentrations require prior consultation with the approval of the department chair. Plans will normally include at least 33 upper division semester hours to include at least 12 semester hours in each of two languages plus approved course work in a third language.

Japanese Minor

For a Japanese Minor, students must take eighteen hours (JAPN1020, JAPN2010, JAPN2020 and nine upper-division hours). After completion of JAPN2020, it is highly recommended that students take JAPN3301 and 3302 as these courses are prerequisites for other upper-division courses. Students may take JAPN3301 or 3302 and another upper-division course at the same time. To declare Japanese Minor, please contact your academic advisor of your major.

Advanced Placement

A common way students achieve college credit while still in high school is through the Advanced Placement (AP) process.

RETROACTIVE CREDIT

If a student places into 2010, 2020, or the 3000 level, and subsequently takes the appropriate course and passes with a grade of C or better, the student may then request the paperwork to apply for retroactive credit. The cost is \$60 per course.

- If the course taken is 2010, then the student can apply for up to six hours (1010 and 1020).
- If the course taken is 2020, then the student can apply for up to nine hours (1010, 1020, 2010).
- If the course taken is upper-division, the student can apply for up to twelve hours (1010, 1020, 2010, 2020).
