



PhD Student Outstanding Teaching Award

Purpose and Scope

The purpose of the Fogelman College of Business and Economics (FCBE) Ph.D. Student Outstanding Teaching Award is to recognize the teaching excellence of PhD students at either the undergraduate or graduate level. A maximum of three (3) awards will be made each year.

Eligibility

- All FCBE full-time Ph.D. students who have (1) completed at least two full academic years of classes at the University of Memphis and (2) independently taught at least two courses.
- Students may only receive the award once while in the FCBE PhD program

Application

The FCBE Associate Dean for Academic Programs and Research will issue a call for applications in the Spring semester. Applications shall consist of:

- Two (2)-page statement summarizing the applicant's teaching philosophy, description of teaching innovations, pedagogical methods, use of technology, and other relevant information
- Course syllabi
- SETE summaries and comments for all courses taught

Applications must be submitted via email to the Associate Dean for Academic Programs and Research by the due date specified in the call for applications.

Evaluation Process

Applications will be evaluated by the PhD Sub-council. The Ph.D. Sub-Council will recommend award winners to the FCBE Associate Dean for Academic Programs and Research. The FCBE Dean, in conjunction with others, will make the award decisions.

Awards

Selected recipients receive a \$1,000 award and a plaque.
