ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

APPLICATION DEADLINES

Fall | March 1

Students applying for the Economics PhD program must submit their scores on the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT), provide three letters of reference, a resume or CV and transcripts from all institutions of higher learning attended attesting to the courses taken and/or degrees earned and verifying their successful completion. In addition, students will need to provide a short personal statement, explaining why the applicant wants to pursue graduate studies in economics at our institution.

THE DOCTORAL CONCENTRATION IN ECONOMICS

at the University of Memphis is a 72-credit hour graduate degree with a rigorous curriculum providing core economic theory and applied analytical and empirical methods. We offer small class sizes, individual attention and flexibility in coursework.
