# **BBA Degree Requirements**

# **GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) AND GRADE REQUIREMENTS**

To qualify for the Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.) degree, students must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours with a minimum **Overall and Institutional** grade point average (GPA) of **2.00** 

- A cumulative GPA of **2.25** is required in the Lower Division Business Core
  - o ACCT majors must have a cumulative GPA of a **2.5** in the Lower Core
- A cumulative GPA of **2.00** is required for the Upper Division Business Core and Major courses
- A **minimum grade of "C-"** is required in all Lower Division Business Core, Upper Division Business Core, and Major courses
  - o ACCT majors require a minimum grade of "B- "in ACCT 2010 and 2020

# **REPEAT COURSES**

- B.B.A. students are only allowed to attempt each Business course in which they receive a letter grade lower than a C-, <u>a maximum of 3 times</u>.
  - If the student is unsuccessful on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final attempt of a Lower Core or Upper Core course, he or she will be **dismissed** from the College of Business and **ineligible** to continue to pursue a BBA degree
  - If the student is unsuccessful on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final attempt of a Major course, he or she will be ineligible to pursue that major

#### **UPPER DIVISION BUSINESS COURSE (3000-4000 LEVEL) ELIGIBILITY**

 B.B.A. students are required to complete all courses in the Lower Division Business Core along with ENGL 1010, ENGL 1020, COMM 2381, and Literature <u>before</u> they are eligible to take Upper Division Business Courses

## **PHED COURSES**

• B.B.A. students may apply no more than <u>2</u> semester hours of Physical Activity (PHED) courses to the minimum 120 hours required for the degree

## INTERNSHIP AND INDEPENDENT STUDY COURSE CREDIT

• B.B.A. students may apply no more than <u>6</u> hours of <u>Internship and Independent Study</u> credit toward their Major requirements. Students may apply no more than a **maximum of <u>9</u> hours combined** Internship and Independent study credit hours toward the major requirements.

# Pass/Fail Grading

• All courses used to satisfy specific degree requirements for the B.B.A. degree must be taken on a "Letter Grade" OR "Credit by Examination" basis. Courses taken on an "audit" basis cannot be used to satisfy B.B.A. requirements.
