University Benefits Update

University Benefits Update

- Flexible Spending Account (FSA)
 - Carryover feature
- Health Savings Account (HSA)
 - Seed money
- Insurance Cards
 - Caremark Pharmacy Card

Parental Leave Policy Update

Eligibility

- Leave available to biological or adoptive parents
- Staff and Faculty (includes Post-docs) must be employed at the University in a regular position for 12 continuous months prior to the birth or adoption of a child to be eligible
- Six weeks of PPL to be used over a 12 month period
- If the 6 weeks of leave end during a semester, faculty may request modified duties until the end of the semester
- Up to 3 PPL during an employee's career at the University

Parental Leave Policy Update

Salary Replacement Cost

 Salary replacements cost will be covered by the University, however, it is expected that salary replacements for auxiliary, restricted, or revenue generating units be funded from within the unit.

Parental Leave Policy Update

Repayment

- If employee fails to return to work after the PPL for a minimum of 90 days, they will have to reimburse the University for the salary received while on PPL. The following exception to reimbursing the university applies:
 - If the employee is employed by the university for a minimum of 5 years, or
 - If the employee cannot return to work after the leave due to a medical condition of the employee or the child.

 (completed by faculty member)
