Curriculum:

a. Edits to Admission regulations in the Graduate School Catalog. After student enrollment hits then the GS will verify documents other than the foreign language test requirement which will be verified at admission as that is a requirement to issue an I20.

- **b.** Deadlines: Try as you can to clean up department deadlines or streamline where possible. Please keep in mind international student deadlines.

Admission Standards/requirements catalog edits/updates Summer 2023: We need to place admission standards in the graduate catalog. This is very important and will be clear to applicants that standards are accurately reflected within the catalog. Exceptions can be made but clearly spell it out. Add please that meeting minimum department standards does not guarantee admissions would be helpful to add to your verbiage too. Updates need to be complete by September 1, 2023. No curriculum from a college will be approved until the admission standards are complete.

Enrollment Seat Deposit Update: Deb briefed all on the removal of the enrollment seat deposit as we were asked to not require the seat deposit going forward and refunds will be given accordingly.
