MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING OF AFFLIATION BETWEEN CHURCH HEALTH CENTER AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MEMPHIS

The Church Health Center and The University of Memphis ("University") share a common mission to benefit the underserved populations of the Greater Memphis area. Whereas, Church Health Center and University wish to collaborate and to partner in regard to the achievement of mutually-beneficial goals, it is agreed as follows:

- 1. Church Health Center and University will work together to provide meaningful opportunities for collaborative research among University students and faculty and the Church Health Center in the areas of wellness and health to benefit the underserved populations of the Memphis area.
- 2. Church Health Center and University will offer collaborative, reciprocal programming to provide a deeper educational experience for undergraduate and graduate students at the University and the staff of the Church Health Center.
- 3. University will provide access to educational opportunities in accordance with regular University offerings and programmings and subject to general admission requirements for Church Health Center staff to further their education in order to fulfill their mission of providing quality care and service for the underserved and to support the University's mission as a learner-centered metropolitan research university.
- 4. Church Health Center will provide health coverage for Graduate Assistants at the University of Memphis through the Church Health Center's Memphis Plan in order to support these vital members of the University community as determined by a separately executed contract.
- 5. Church Health Center and University understand that some of the commitments as outlined in this Memorandum of Understanding may be subject to further approvals by their respective governing bodies.

6. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be governed by the laws of the State of Tennessee and shall be effective for one year from the date of execution and may renew for successive years but no longer than five years.
