Instructions for Community Course Students

Information for applicants already in Memphis - NOT for F1 (student) visa applicants

The following materials must be submitted to the IEI office when applying:

- Completed, signed Community Courses Application Form
- Application fee (\$25)

All fees must be paid by the final day of registration posted on the IEI web site. Applications may be submitted in person, by email, by fax or by mail. Payment may be made by check, money order, credit card or cash. Checks or money orders may be mailed, but please do not mail cash. Do **not** send credit card information directly to the IEI office. If you wish to pay by credit card, come in person to the IEI office or contact us for instructions.

Please be aware that classes will be cancelled the Friday before the first class if there have not been enough students to register. You will be informed by phone or by email if this happens.

The IEI Office

Parking

Students driving to the university should get a general parking tag from the University Parking Office. The cost is \$14 for a semester (2 sessions). 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Community Courses

Intermediate Communication Skills 6:00 – 8:00 p.m., Tuesdays and Thursdays \$330

The Communication Skills class is for intermediate learners of English who wish to work on their spoken English communication skills.

Writing Workshop

6:00 – 8:00 p.m., Mondays

\$165

The Writing Workshop is designed for internationals who need to develop their English writing skills. The course is designed around the specific needs of the students.

Pronunciation Skills

6:00 – 8:00 p.m., Tuesdays

\$165

The Pronunciation class focuses on the mechanics of Standard English pronunciation. Students will receive both individual and group instruction and practice.

TOEFL Preparation

6:00 - 8:00 p.m., Wenesdays

The TOEFL Prep class provides an overview of the TOEFL iBT test to help students prepare more thoroughly. A high-intermediate – advanced level of English is assumed.

Basic Communication Skills

9:30 – 11:30 a.m., Saturday Mornings

The Basic English class is designed for people who are beginning to learn English but cannot come to the intensive daytime classes. The class includes grammar, reading, writing, listening and speaking.

Business English

9:30 – 11:30 a.m., Saturday Mornings \$165

The Business English for Internationals Course designed to give international students the opportunity to practice oral forms of business communication needed for socializing, communicating by telephone, making presentations and conducting meetings. Some time will also be spent working on various written forms of business communication.
