Instructions for Community Course Students

The following materials must be brought to the IEI office when applying:

- Application fee (\$25)

All fees must be paid by the application deadline.

Please be aware that classes will be cancelled the Friday before the class if there have not been enough students to register. You will be informed by phone if this happens.

The IEI Office

The IEI office is located on the second floor of the Panhellenic Building on the main UM campus in room 205. The Panhellenic Building is next to the FedEx Institute of Technology building at the intersection of Patterson Street and Veterans Avenue.

Parking

Students driving to the university should get a general parking tag from the University Parking Office. The cost is \$14 for a semester (2 sessions).
