

IEI Program Fee

All IEI students studying in our intensive daytime program are required to pay a university fee called the **IEI Program Fee**. This fee is charged by the university three times each year: once for the fall semester, once for the spring semester, and once for the summer. Even though IEI has two sessions during the fall and spring semesters, they are only required to pay the fee once during the fall and once during the spring. The fee remains the same for the summer session. The fee is set by the university each year in July and is only 1/3 of the price that undergraduate students pay. - 500 sheets of paper printing from university computer labs each semester
- Free access to the university health center - you can see a doctor free of charge

- Free entrance to all university events open to students except Tiger sporting events
