

**Title:** I-75 Corridor Feasibility Study

**Description:**

The purpose of the I-75 Corridor Feasibility Study is to obtain a more detailed understanding of the deficiencies of the corridor and then develop corridor level multi-modal solutions to address these deficiencies. The report will document the deficiencies along I-75 associated with:

- Capacity and Congestion
- Horizontal and Vertical Geometry
- Operations and Maintenance
- Safety and Security
- Freight Movement and Diversion
- Economic Access
- Intermodal Facilities

As the plan will identify short, mid, and long-term solutions, the deficiencies are identified for the time horizons of 2011, 2016, and 2030, respectively.
