International Research Award

The International Studies Program, Study Abroad Office, and Helen Hardin Honors Program are partnering to fund 3-6 International Research Travel Awards for Summer 2016. The purpose of this program is to provide undergraduate students with opportunities to pursue research in international settings, under the guidance of a faculty member. Faculty members benefit from research assistance in the field.

Program Supports:

- ✓ \$1000 allowance to undergraduate student for international travel and accommodations
- ✓ \$650-\$1000 professional support funds for the full-time faculty mentor (for travel support and research related expenses)
- ✓ Faculty working with <u>Honors</u> students may be eligible for \$1000 research allowance for supplies to be used in direct support of the research project under the Honors Program Summer Research Fellowship (see below)

Student Eligibility:

- ✓ Open to undergraduate students majoring in International Studies who will enroll for at least one semester at the University of Memphis as an undergraduate student after completion of the research
- ✓ <u>Honors</u> students in International Studies also eligible to apply for \$2400 summer research stipend (see below)

Faculty Eligibility:

✓ Open to faculty with an active research project in an international setting, with priority given to International Studies Faculty Affiliates.

Application:

- ✓ Submit application form as a faculty-student pair to kbrondo@memphis.edu by April 1, 2016.
- ✓ 750-1000 word statement of nature of research and student responsibilities, plus a timeline for research activities, and simple budget.
- ✓ Applicants for the Honors Program Summer Research Fellowship must submit the additional separate application to Honors Program

Honors Program Summer Research Fellowship

Up to 10 stipends at \$2,400 each will be awarded to support honors students who will work with a University of Memphis full-time faculty mentor in the summer of 2016. Students will also receive an allowance of \$1,000 for supplies and services to be used in direct support of the research project.
