



GRADE BY QUESTION IN SPEEDGRADER

Grading essay questions in New Quizzes is easier with the new Grade by Question feature in SpeedGrader. This feature updates the navigation of SpeedGrader to allow you to grade an individual question and then move to the next student to grade the very same question. The change in workflow for grading may make it easier for you to grade answers that require a lot of focus. TURNITIN AI WRITING DETECTION

Turnitin has a new feature that allows you to detect if assignments have been written using AI. The service is available through the regular Turnitin plagiarism detection already present in Canvas. To learn how to turn on Turnitin for an assignment in Canvas, watch this UM3D tutorial video. To use this extra feature in Turnitin after you have created an assignment that uses Turnitin and students have submitted to it, watch this UM3D tutorial video on Turnitin AI Writing Detection.

1. View the report from Turninin.




2. The percentage of AI generated text will appear in the bottom right-hand of Turnitin report.

Click on this and it will highlight AI generated text.

RINGCENTRAL

CHANGES TO DUO

Reminding everyone that DUO Security is updating its two-factor authentication interface to Universal Prompt (UP). The UofM will implement this change for all users on May 5, 2023. While no action is necessary for most users, you can read more details about this update on our website.

Phone calls for authentication will be phased out starting July 5, 2023. Users currently using the Call option as their verification method will need to choose an alternative option. CHANGES TO THE TA CANVAS ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Per the Registrar's Office, as of April 14, 2023, all TAs and GAs should be added to semester sections through Banner. TAs/GAs (legacy TA Designer and TA Grader roles) will no longer be added manually to Banner-generated sections in Canvas by Department Aides or the UM3D team. All TA/GA additions will need to be added to semester sections by department schedulers.

Once a TA/GAs contract has been approved and FERPA training has been completed, your department scheduler can add TAs and GAs to applicable sections or the department scheduler can place a ticket to have TAs/GAs faculty role activated. This may be submitted via the Registrar's Office <u>Academic Section Maintenance Request</u>.

Once added to Banner, TAs/GAs will appear as instructors (with instructor-level permissions) in their assigned Canvas course. TAs/GAs will also appear as instructors in Banner with the instructor of record/primary instructor designated in Banner via (P).
