Event Times can be Input Manually (All Users)

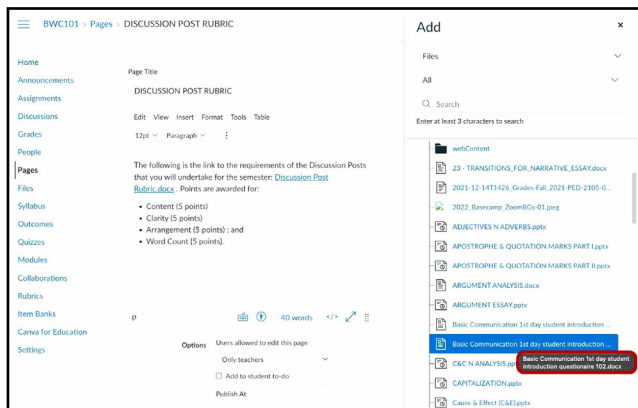
When creating or editing an event, users can manually input event times. Additionally, the time increments in the drop-down menu are changed to 15-minute increments. This update provides users the option to create time frames outside of the default 15 minute increment drop-down menu options.

RICH CONTENT EDITOR

Course File Hover Displays Entire File Name

When viewing course files with long and similar names in the Rich Content Editor (RCE), users can hover over the file name to view the full name. This update allows users to easily differentiate between similar long file names.

Note: This update is not available for file folders.

The Grades page displays a submitted column that provides the date an assignment is submitted. This update allows students and observers to easily view when an assignment was submitted.

Note: If an assignment allows multiple attempts, the column only displays the most recent submission date.

RICH CONTENT EDITOR

Height and Width Attributes Supported

When using HTML in the Rich Content Editor, width and height attributes on <source> are supported. This update prevents content on the page from rearranging during image loading. Additionally, this enhances the user experience by ensuring that the necessary space is predetermined before loading occurs.

NEW myMemphis Portal

The University of Memphis is undergoing a significant transformation in the myMemphis portal, bidding farewell to the longstanding Ellucian system after 15+ years of service. Set to retire in June 2024, the current system will be replaced by the cutting-edge campusM platform developed by Ex Libris. This transition hopes to enhance functionality, particularly through the mobile application, and facilitates seamless integration with popular platforms such as Canvas, Banner, and Microsoft products.

campusM is optimized for use across various platforms, providing a better experience through its mobile application. Unlike the existing system, campusM readily accepts custom applications developed by the University of Memphis, promoting smoother integration and a tailored experience for users.

UofM's Web and Mobile Services is actively engaged in refining the campusM experience based on user feedback. A dedicated 'Feedback' tile on the portal encourages users to share their insights. One notable feedback-driven improvement is the introduction of an 'Arrange' feature in campusM, allowing users to customize their layouts by adding, removing, or reorganizing items to suit their preferences.

The soft roll out of the new campusM system began in December 2023, running concurrently with the existing myMemphis portals (Luminis and campusM) throughout the Spring Semester 2024. UofM's Web and Mobile Services team is actively promoting the usage of the new system during this period. 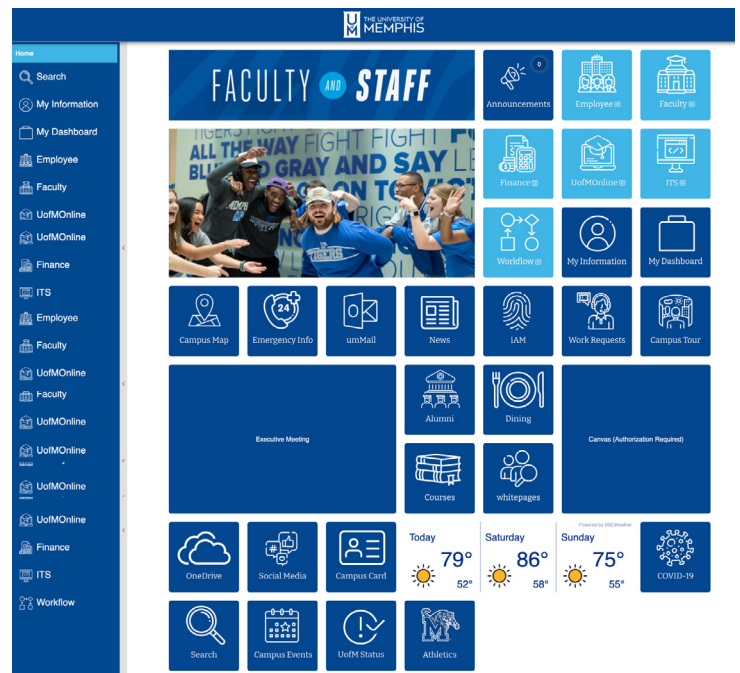
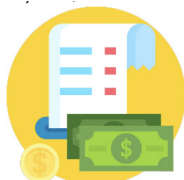
ZOOM TO TEAMS TRANSITION

In March 2020, ITS promptly implemented and introduced Zoom to address the urgent need for a virtual meeting platform for academics and administration. Over time, Microsoft has made substantial investments in advancing their online collaboration platform, Microsoft Teams. Following a thorough examination of budgets and feature comparisons between the two platforms, we will capitalize on our longstanding partnership with Microsoft and adopt the collaboration tool Microsoft Teams.
