Duo's Universal prompt testing is going well and looking to expand the test group to a larger audience.
Discussion Item	Timothy	Duo telephony deprecation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Moving toward deprecating SMS and phone calls for Duo authentication and expected date is set for June 30, 2023. Currently deprecating and purchasing will go into effect the end of June. There are options provided to get fobs or by-passes to print off in order have access when setting up new Smart Devices. The fobs are \$20.00 as of now.
Discussion item	Timothy	NAC deployment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are moving forward with NAC rollout. The Network Access Control (NAC) project is continuing into the Academic buildings and will occur throughout the spring semester. This is to increase security into controlling who is allowed to access our network, and require an agent be installed to be compliant. All agents have been deployed previously. Therefore, no downtime is expected and impacted parties will be notified by their

			LSPs and through the change management system (if they are subscribed) when their buildings are scheduled to be turned on for the NAC. Unmanaged switch locations will be exempt from NAC implementations at this time.

Discussion item	Timothy	PCI Gap Analysis and Annual Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The PCI Gap Analysis is scheduled for February 6th-8th. • The vendor will be working remotely and with multiple departments for the University to go over PCI environment and policies.
