Positions Overview & Summary of Job Function:

W.O.W. Leaders will assist Lambuth Student Services Staff in the planning, marketing, & facilitation of Weeks of Welcome (Fall & Spring) as well as Frosh Fusion.

Position Qualifications:

- The minimum overall GPA considered for this position is 2.5, to be maintained throughout the length of your employment
- A student must be enrolled full-time for the semester during which they will work and will remain enrolled full-time throughout employment with the office.
- A student must be in good academic, financial, and/or student discipline standing with the University.
- Student must be comfortable speaking to large groups.
- Student must demonstrate leadership & enthusiasm for the campus experience.
- Must attend sessions prior to the start of the Fall semester (July/August)
- Must attend sessions for Winter Welcome towards the end of the Fall semester (Nov./Dec)
- Must assist with the facilitation of Weeks of Welcome activities
- Must complete classroom visits at the start of each semester.

Position Compensation:

W.O.W leaders will be paid a \$150 stipend via one-time payment contract at the conclusion of Weeks of Welcome (Fall), and the conclusion of Winter Welcome (Spring) for a total of \$300.

\$150 (4 planning hours, 7 hours for events & prep, 1.5 hours for classroom visits each semester at a rate of \$12/hr)

Students that also work Frosh Fusion will receive an additional \$150.

Students that do not work the full hours listed will receive a cut to their stipend.
