¹Orientations for each of the offered Clinics will be scheduled for the first three-to-four weeks of the semester according to a schedule to be determined by the Director of each Clinic after conferring with enrolled students. The Clinic orientation schedule will be communicated to enrolled students in advance of the semester's start.

²In addition to the weekly class session, Mediation Clinic students must commit to participate in mandatory, full-day orientation sessions to be scheduled on the first two Saturdays of the spring semester. Each Mediation Clinic student will be required to pay a fee of \$100 to cover costs related to the Rule 31 training offered as part of the course curriculum. The Tennessee Alternative Dispute Resolution Commission also charges at the time of application an additional fee of \$100.

³In addition to the weekly class session, Neighborhood Preservation Clinic students will need to commit to a weekly Environmental Court docket on Thursday mornings (10:15 a.m.-12:45 p.m.) or Thursday afternoons (1:15 p.m.-3:45 p.m.).

⁴Students who have previously taken a fall or spring Clinic course are eligible to enroll as an Advanced Clinic student in that same clinic. If you have questions, please see the Professor who directs and teaches the base Clinic course.

⁵Permit required. Advanced Criminal Prosecution is a 1-credit, ungraded course offered during the Law School's 2019 Spring Break. The course will meet each day from Monday, March 4 to Friday, March 8, 2019. Applications for enrollment in the Advanced Criminal Prosecution course are DUE to Professor Danny Schaffzin (danny.s@memphis.edu) no later than Friday, November 2nd, at 5:00 pm. Enrollment offers will be extended before the opening of spring semester registration. Please contact Professor Schaffzin with any questions.
