### Social Security Disability Law



#### What is Social Security Disability Law?

Social Security Disability attorneys assist clients in the Social Security Disability Insurance application and appeals processes. Social Security Disability attorneys advise clients regarding their applications, collect medical evidence and sort through medical records to determine the best evidence, communicate with the Social Security Administration on behalf of their clients, file appeals in the case that an initial application for benefits is denied, and provide assistance during Social Security claims hearings before administrative law judges (Disability Benefits).

Social Security Disability attorneys are especially important in the appeals process. Social Security attorneys might also assit in cases in which a client's benefits have been reduced by the Social Security Administration. Such cases can also be challenged through an appeals process that may include a hearing before an administrative law judge (Joyce, Disability Benefits).

Social Security Disability attorneys are experts in administrative law and the Social Security Act. The <u>Social Security Act</u> was passed in 1935 to establish payroll-tax-funded pension fund for retirees. It has since been amended several times to include disability, survivor, and dependent benefits. (Grover).
