¹Orientations for each of the offered Clinics will be scheduled for the first three-to-four weeks of the semester according to a schedule to be determined by the Director of each Clinic.

²The Housing Adjudication Clinic will meet for up to 100 minutes of regularly scheduled classroom time each week, likely on Monday afternoons. In addition, clinic students will sit as hearing officers on Wednesday afternoons (1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.) each week of the semester. Students who plan to enroll in the clinic ought to avoid class conflicts on Monday and Wednesday afternoons.

³In addition to the weekly class session, Mediation Clinic students must commit to participate in mandatory, full-day orientation sessions to be scheduled on the first two Saturdays of the spring semester. Each Mediation Clinic student will be required to pay a fee of \$100 to cover costs related to the Rule 31 training offered as part of the course curriculum. The Tennessee Alternative Dispute Resolution Commission also charges at the time of application an additional fee of \$100.

⁴In addition to the weekly class session, Neighborhood Preservation Clinic students will need to commit to a weekly Environmental Court docket on Thursday mornings (10:15 a.m.-12:45 p.m.) or Thursday afternoons (1:15 p.m.-3:45 p.m.).

⁵Students who have previously taken one of the six fall/spring Clinics are eligible to enroll as an Advanced Clinic student in that same clinic. If you have questions, please see the Professor who directs and teaches the base Clinic course.

⁶Permit required. Advanced Criminal Prosecution is a 1-credit, ungraded course offered during the Law School's 2018 Spring Break. The Course will meet each day from Monday, March 5 to Friday, March 9, 2017. Applications for enrollment in the Advanced Criminal Prosecution course are DUE to Professor Danny Schaffzin (danny.s@memphis.edu) no later than Tuesday, October 31st, at 4:30 p.m. Enrollment offers will be extended before the opening of spring semester registration.
