Required Grade

- C or better

Experiential Learning Requirement

Eligible Courses – Choose 6 CHs

- Simulation Courses (e.g., Trial Advocacy)
- Clinics
- Externships

Relevant Requirements

- At least 1 clinic or externship
- C or better/Satisfactory or better

Relevant Limitations

- 10 clinic hours MAX
- 3 externship/clinic courses MAX
- 1 clinic or externship at a time

General Limitations

MAX Ungraded (Pass/Fail) Hours

- 12 hours

MAX Hours Per Semester

- PT: 11 hours
- FT: 18 hours
- FT with GPA below 2.50: 16 hours
- FT with externship: 16 hours

MIN Hours Per Semester

- PT: 8 hours
- FT: 12 hours
