Re: Contracting with entities hosting programs/activities involving minor children

All individuals or entities leasing University space to provide services or activities for minors (individuals under the age of 18) must comply with the following:

- For those individuals or organizations who have NOT entered into contracts with the University, for future contracts:
 - Completion of the Minors on Campus amendment to the Facilities Use Agreement. (see attached Addendum A)
 - Proof of comprehensive liability insurance including an appropriate amount of sexual abuse and molestation insurance, and must name the University of Memphis as an additional insured. Proof of insurance must be provided to the appropriate department at least seven (7) days prior to the scheduled use of University property or facilities.
- Individuals/Organizations with existing contracts:
 - Certification of the completion of background checks and sex offender registry checks for all employees and volunteers involved, including student volunteers. (see attached **Addendum** B)
 - Proof of comprehensive liability insurance. Proof of insurance must be provided at least seven (7) days prior to the scheduled use of University property or facilities.

Attached as **Addendum C** is a notification regarding the state law mandatory reporting requirement which can be distributed for use in satisfying the certification requirements.

REPORTING RESPONSIBILITIES

Mandatory reporters of child abuse and neglect.

Tennessee Code Annotated 37-1-403(i)(1) requires all persons to report suspected cases of child abuse or neglect. "Any person who has knowledge of or is called upon to render aid to any child who is suffering from or has sustained any wound, injury, disability, or physical or mental condition, shall report such harm immediately if the harm is of such a nature as to reasonably indicated that it has been caused by brutality abuse, or neglect or that, on basis of available information, reasonably appears to have been caused by brutality, abuse, or neglect."

What to do if you suspect that a minor has been abused or neglected or is otherwise unsafe.

If you know, suspect, or receive information indicating that a minor has been abused or neglected, or if you have other concerns about a situation involving the safety of minors, follow the procedures below.

Emergencies

In case of an emergency, immediately call University of Memphis's Police Services emergency number at 901.678.HELP(4357) or 911.

• All Other Reports of Known or Suspected Abuse or Neglect of Minors

Anyone participating in a University-run or affiliated program or activity involving minors or non-University program or activity operating on campus involving minors who knows, suspects, or receives information indicating that a minor has been abused or neglected, or who has other concerns about the safety of minors MUST inform University Police Services who will determine appropriate next steps.

Anyone who knows or suspects abuse or neglect of minors may also notify the Memphis Police Department or Shelby County Sheriff's Office.
