## \$2,500-\$10,000 Scholarships for Math and Engineering Students

The Urban STEM Collaboratory invites applications for the 2019-2020 STEM Scholars program. Scholarships are awarded in a range of \$2,500-\$10,000 per academic year and are renewable through your senior year based on continued eligibility and funding availability. Scholars will become a part of a STEM Community and will engage in a variety of academic, social, and career support programs designed to help them succeed academically and professionally.

### Eligibility:

- \* Open to **Engineering or Mathematical Sciences majors**
- \* Must be an entering freshman or rising sophomore at the time of application
- \* Minimum GPA of 2.8 for college students or 3.0 for high school students
- \* Must have at least a 26 composite score on the ACT or equivalent
- \* Must be eligible for financial aid as determined by the FAFSA

### To apply:

- \* Complete the online application
- \* Submit two letters of recommendation from high school or college faculty
- \* Application review begins Feb, 15, 2019 and will continue until all spots are filled
