\$2,500-\$10,000 Scholarships for Math and Engineering Students

The Urban STEM Collaboratory invites applications for the 2020-2021 STEM Scholars program. Scholarships are awarded in a range of \$2,500-\$10,000 per academic year and are renewable through your senior year based on continued eligibility and funding availability. Scholars will become a part of a STEM Community and will engage in a variety of academic, social, and career support programs designed to help them succeed academically and professionally.

Eligibility:

- * Open to **Engineering or Mathematical Sciences majors**
- * Must be an entering or current freshman at the time of application
- * Minimum high school GPA of 3.0 for entering freshman
- * Minimum college GPA of 2.8 for current freshmen
- * Minimum 26 composite score on the ACT, or equivalent
- * Must be eligible for financial aid as determined by the FAFSA

To apply:

- * Complete the online application
- * Be sure to include names and email addresses for two references (high school or college faculty or administrators)
- * Application review begins February 21, 2020 and will continue until all spots are filled
