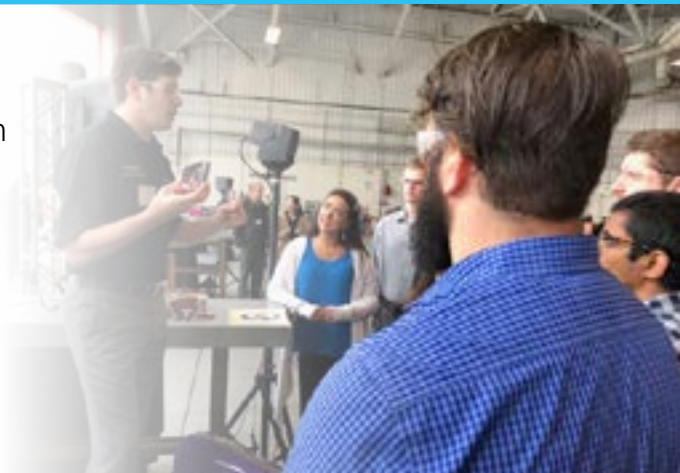
### Eligibility:

- \* Open to **Engineering or Mathematical Sciences majors**
- \* Must be an entering or current freshman at the time of application
- \* Minimum high school GPA of 3.0 for entering freshman
- \* Minimum college GPA of 2.8 for current freshmen
- \* Minimum 26 composite score on the ACT, or equivalent
- \* Must be eligible for financial aid as determined by the FAFSA

### To apply:

- \* Complete the online application
- \* Be sure to include names and email addresses for two references (high school or college faculty or administrators)
- \* Application review begins Feb, 22, 2019 and will continue until all spots are filled
