ELIGIBILITY

- Open to undergraduate sophomore, junior, or senior engineering majors at UofM
- Minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA
- Must be low-income and have unmet financial need as determined by the UofM Office of Financial Aid
- U.S. Citizen
