Musicology & Music Theory (total 3 credits)

Any graduate music theory or history course may fulfill this requirement with the exception of individual studies, applied pedagogy, or repertory courses. Whichever area (history or theory) was taken during the first four semesters, the opposite should be taken below. For example, if theory was chosen as the doctoral course during the first four semesters, then a history course should be taken to fulfill this requirement.

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Recommended Degree Timeline

This timeline is recommended as a guide when creating a student's degree plan.

First Semester Register for 9 credits.

- Check with the Music Graduate Studies Office to make sure that you are categorized as both DMA and MM.
- Register for any required remedial courses.
- Review any foreign language requirements for the degree concentration.
 - o (see 3.9 in the Graduate Handbook)
- Review the degree plan with your major professor and begin to map out the timeline for completing the degree.

Second Semester Register for 9 credits.

- Complete any foreign language requirements.
- Submit degree plan to the School of Music Graduate Studies Office.
- Fulfill the residency requirement by completing at least two successive semesters as a full-time student.
- Perform first graduate recital (MM recital use MUAP 8999 for registration).

Third Semester Register for 9 credits.

- Establish doctoral committee in consultation with major professor.
 - o (see 8.2 in the Graduate Handbook)
- Begin discussing possible DMA cognate options with major professor.

Fourth Semester Register for 9 credits.

- · Begin discussing document/dissertation topics with major professor and doctoral committee.
- Take the MM Comprehensive Examination.
 - o (see 6.3 in the Graduate Handbook)
- Perform second graduate recital (first DMA recital)

Fifth Semester Register for 9 credits.

• Submit and present document/dissertation proposal to doctoral committee.

Sixth Semester Register for 10 credits

- Take the Qualifying Exams the week before the semester begins.
 - o (see 8.7 in the Graduate Handbook)
- Perform third graduate recital (second DMA recital).

Seventh Semester Register for 9 credits

- Wind Conducting concentration submits compilation recital to the doctoral committee if not performing a chamber recital.
- Take written and oral Comprehensive Exams.
 - o (see 8.8 in the Graduate Handbook)
- Once the Comprehensive Exams are passed doctoral candidacy is granted.

Eighth Semester Register for 8 credits

- At the beginning of the semester, apply to graduate for both the DMA and the MM degrees.
 - o (see 3.5 in the Graduate Handbook)
- Submit approved dissertation to your doctoral committee at least one month in advance of the defense.
 - o (see 8.11 in the Graduate Handbook)
- Perform final recital/lecture recital and defend the document/dissertation.
- Submit a copy of the final version of the document/dissertation to the Graduate School.
