The School of Music has partnered with the Memphis Symphony Orchestra in a historic collaboration to train tomorrow's musicians and provides regular performance and internship opportunities with Opera Memphis, Memphis Chamber Music Society, and the music industry. The School is scheduled to open a brand new, state-of-the-art facility, the Scheidt Family Music Center, in spring 2022. In a city teeming with performance venues, it adds to the wonderful sound by presenting more concerts and events than any music organization in the region.
