Estefan Perez

The Inaugural Memphis Symphony Orchestra Fellow and winner of several scholarships and performance-based grants, cellist **Estefan Perez** will be making his second appearance as a soloist with an orchestra this evening. Being of Dominican heritage, his Paranov Concerto Competition win at The Hartt School in Hartford, CT was the first time a student of Hispanic origin had won in over 15 years. Estefan began his studies in cello at the age of 9, but was not able to take private lessons until the age of 15. Since then, he has gone on to perform as a soloist, chamber musician, collaborator, and guest artist in various locations across the Northeast, and now Memphis. A native of Long Island, New York, Estefan enjoys playing tennis and trying out new restaurants in his spare time. He is currently a student of Dr. Kimberly Patterson, at the Rudi E. Scheidt School of Music.
