ORIENTATION CHECKOUT PROCESS

In order to complete the New Student Orientation program, students must bring a printed copy of their schedule to checkout in the Beale Room on the 3rd floor of the University Center. Checkout begins at 1:30 p.m.

STEP 1 | COMPLETE NSO EVALUATION | UC 265 (OG Small Groups) Students will complete an orientation survey on a computer in the

Students will complete an orientation survey on a computer in the Tech Hub or on their phones. Proof of completion must be shown at Step 3 in order to receive their Student ID and a UofM class t-shirt.

STEP 2 | REGISTRATION ASSISTANCE | UC 265 (OG Small Groups)

(If needed) Visit the Tech Hub on the 2nd floor of the UC where the Orientation Guides will help you schedule days and times for your classes if needed. This is also where you can print a copy of your schedule for checkout!

STEP 3 | CHECKOUT | UC Beale Room

This is the final step in the NSO process. Please make sure you check out on the 3rd floor of the UC to pick up your Student ID. Once you've completed the checkout process, you will get a free class t-shirt and lunch!
