- Minimum of 60 completed college credit hours before program entry
- Submission of professional resume, letter of interest, and 2 references
- Official transcripts from all colleges attended are required
- Applicants must be admitted to UofM or be an active UofM student
- Transfer applicants must submit an official transcript and a letter of good standing from the Dean of their previous nursing program.
