ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Minimum prerequisite GPA of 3.0 for nursing core prerequisites
- Completion of required prerequisite coursework
- Minimum of 60 completed college credit hours prior to program entry
- Submission of professional resume, letter of interest, and 2 references
- Official transcripts from all colleges attended are required
- Applicants must be admitted to UofM or be an active UofM student for their intended start term
- Transfer applicants must submit an official transcript and a letter of good standing from the Dean of their previous nursing program. Applicants must have earned a minimum grade of C in all nursing courses.

- Microbiology w/ Lab
- Statistics

Only one nursing prerequisite course (including its lab) may be repeated one time. The second earned grade will be used in the prerequisite GPA calculation. All other prerequisite courses will use the first earned grade. Science courses must be completed within five years of LCON admission.
