## **PSYCHOLOGY FIELD TEST:**

All psychology majors are required to take a major area achievement test during their senior year. Students may sign up for the PSYC Field Test in the Academic Advising and Resource Center, in room 205 in the Psychology Building, (678-2543).

## **ACADEMIC CHECK-OUT FOR GRADUATION:**

All PSYC students must meet with their Advisor, Marion Powless to check out for graduation as soon as they reach senior status (85 hours or more); then go to the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) office in Scates Hall 107 to file their Intent to Graduate form. Once the student has filed the Intent to Graduate form, the graduation analyst will complete the Summary of Coursework Remaining form and will mail copies to the student and to the advisor. The student should meet with their advisor to review the form and discuss remaining coursework and graduation requirements. The student may leave the Summary form for completion in the Academic Advising & Resource Center (AARC) in the PSYC dept. After both the advisor and student have signed the Summary of Coursework Remaining form, the student returns the signed copy to the CAS so he or she can be added to the graduation list.
