School MA/EdS | March 1 (early

admission) and May 1

School PhD | Dec 1

Minimum Admission Requirements

- Undergraduate GPA of at least 2.5
- At least 12 semester hours in psychology courses
- Letters of recommendation from three people familiar with applicant's academic potential

Timeframe

For all of our programs, new students are admitted once per year, to begin coursework in the fall semester.
