



### ***Why should I do this?***

Having your research published will be a competitive addition to your resume for pursuing graduate studies or professional research. Also, monetary prizes will be awarded to the authors of the best papers in each issue.

### ***Who's eligible?***

University of Memphis students doing undergraduate coursework

### ***Are co-authored papers eligible?***

Yes. All primary authors should be U of M undergrads. You can submit work up to a year after graduation as long as your research was done as an undergraduate at U of M.

### ***Will I be able to publish my submission elsewhere?***

Once your paper is published in *Quaesitum*, it can't be published elsewhere in its same form.

### ***I already presented my work at Works In Progress, can I still submit?***

Yes. Please do!

### ***Is my paper a good fit?***

Maybe. You need to have collected some kind of data and analyzed it in some way. Feel free to ask us about your paper.

### ***Do you want papers on any particular topics?***

No. Articles cover a wide range of topics and academic fields, ranging from scientific research to literary analysis. Our goal is to provide opportunities for students in all departments.

### ***Do I have to submit a paper from my major?***

No. Any research paper is fine as long as you have analyzed some data and have a faculty sponsor.

### ***Are there some kinds of papers you don't want?***

Annotated bibliographies, rhetorical analyses, synthesis papers, and works of creative writing aren't a good fit for *Quaesitum*.

### ***Can I revise my paper before I submit?***

Revise! Use the feedback from your professor and guidance from your faculty sponsor to change the paper from meeting the requirements of a class, to a paper designed to display your work to other scholars.

### ***When is the deadline?***

To be published in the 2017 issue, papers should be submitted by January 20, 2017. If you submit after that date, we can't guarantee that your paper will be in the spring 2017 issue, but it will be rolled over for consideration in the next issue.
