## **Contact Minute Requirements**

The contact minute requirements for each credit hour awarded are 750. A three credit hour lecture course **must** meet a minimum of 2250 minutes per semester. Use of non-standard times should be rare. If non-standard times are used, divide the total number of class meetings into the required number of minutes to determine the length of each class and then determine beginning and ending times. A <u>Non-Standard Course Offering</u> Request Form should be submitted with rationale. (Exceptions: more than 3 hours credit or non-lecture courses)
