Scholarship Acceptance Checklist

1. Establish your official UofM email account

- a. Email is the official communication method of the University of Memphis. The email account is free and you can set it up online at: iam.memphis.edu and click "Initialize Your Account." Enter your unique code.
- b. Important: After your account has been initialized, please enroll in Duo multi-factor authentication by completing steps outlined at https://www.memphis.edu/duo under the "How do I enroll or change my devices in Duo Account Security"?
- c. Future correspondence (registration information, special event invitations, additional scholarship opportunities, etc.) will be sent to this university email address. Contact the Help Desk (901.678.8888) if you cannot access that account. If you have initialized your UofM email account, no additional steps are needed to set up your email.

2. Accept scholarship offer

- a. Log into my.memphis.edu
- b. Click the Financial Aid and Scholarships tile.
- c. Select the 2025-2026 Aid Year from the drop down menu at the top of the page.
- d. Select the **Offer** Tab
- e. View your scholarship and select Accept or Decline under Take Action
- f. Click **Submit**
- g. Review the Terms and Conditions, and acknowledge by checking the box and clicking **Accept Award**

3. 2025-2026 FAFSA and Financial Aid Process

The <u>2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u> is now available. Be sure to complete your FAFSA as soon as possible.

4. Residence Life and Dining Services
