

Student Leadership & Involvement: Social Change Scholars

The Social Change Scholars program is a competitive, cohort style program that brings 25 students together a year in curricular and co-curricular experiences that will expose them to root causes of social issues, as well as equip them with the knowledge and experience to address those issues head-on through service learning, volunteerism and public service experiences. The Social Change Scholars will receive a \$4,400 scholarship per year as participants in this program.

Requirements for participation:

- Demonstrated commitment to service and social justice as evidenced through high school involvement within the community.
- A desire to engage meaningfully in issues of social justice and social change throughout the city of Memphis and the Mid-South.
- A high school GPA minimum of 2.5, a collegiate GPA maintained throughout the program of a 2.75
- 40 hours of service, service learning, or internship experience in the non-profit sector within the Mid-South per year of engagement in the Social Change Scholars program.

Program Learning Outcomes:

- Develop an understanding of social responsibility and the implications of short-term community service versus sustainable social change; Recognition of the relationship between individual, group, community and societal well-being.
- Demonstrate the ability to translate thought into action through meaningful social change projects that engage policy, legislation, political mobilization, grassroots organizing, action research, and/or advocacy.
- Learn from and collaborate with community members, facilitate reciprocal access to and from community and university resources, and collectively build capacity for change.
- Build a classroom learning community in which enhanced critical-thinking skills are developed to better engage systems of power, privilege, and oppression.
