**An Act to Add a Course Difficulty Question to the Student Evaluation of Teacher Effectiveness**

**Whereas**, the University of Memphis Student Evaluation of Teacher Effectiveness currently keeps record of student responses to the question of “What grade do you expect to receive in this course?” **AND**,

**Whereas**, the University of Memphis currently does not offer any responses evaluating the difficulty of the course for student use **AND**,

**Whereas**, the University of Memphis maintains an archive of Student Evaluation of Teacher Effectiveness reports dating back to Fall 2007.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE 68<sup>th</sup> GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:**

**Section 1:** The question, or one similar in nature, “On a scale from 1 – 5, with 1 being the easiest, and 5 being the hardest, how difficult was this course?” shall be added to the Student Evaluation of Teacher Effectiveness.

**Section 2:** A hyperlink to the Student Instructional Rating System/ Student Evaluation of Teacher Effectiveness report archives query page shall be included within the registration process for easy, and clear use to students.

**Section 3:** This bill will cost the Student Government Association zero dollars in funding.

**Section 4:** This bill shall take effect immediately and upon approval of the Senate.
