<u>Guest Speakers:</u> Derek Meyers: Safety App

- LivSafe is going to be the safety app used by students
- A PowerPoint showed what it will look like
- He said that he had some choice about the four main icons shown
- It will be branded with our tiger logo
- Maintenance may be added along with parking
- Occupational Safety and health was also discussed
- Internal audit was also discussed
- Call 911 Center will go straight there and the app is location based
- If the university that you are visiting is using the exact same system, then it will automatically route to that University's information
- If not on campus or a campus it will not work
- Safe walk
  - o Friends can see you walking
  - o They can see if you deviate off the path and they can call police services or themselves
- Dashboard side

- o Dispatcher will see whatever you are sending
- Increased staff so that App can be implemented
- They can plug in anything that they need to put on the APP
- Populate app with anything they want to add
- Questions and request for ideas
  - o As far as maintenance goes it is funneled through star rez. How will it work in conjunction with that?
    - It will be funneled through that and straight to physical plant
    - Cut through the middle man
  - o Is the counseling center included?
    - They will look at including that in the ideas
  - o As far as the dispatcher go Is that taken care of?
    - It has already been taken care of
    - They are getting acclimated now
  - o It will be included everywhere on every campus
  - o Will there be support for tiger athletic events
    - Police services is not under those stadiums.
    - He would have to get the services that provide security to back it
  - o With the other campuses that have this has there been a decrease in crime?
    - He thinks that the amount of reports has increased.
    - It will be a way for them to get it real time
  - o Clarify the launch date
    - January
  - o How far will the main campus stretch?
    - It will use patrol radius.
  - o If there is an incident on Millington or Collierville campus what happens?

  - o Where would it be moved to
    - There are spaces that are far away
- A senator said that she talked to people and said that people were against it but some were for it if it was a general parking lot
- Take away something from the university
- Petition said 120 spots would be created
- The area where Richardson will be green space
- Need to tell people that the garden will not be gone completely
- Alternative spots are being looked at for the parking that will go away
- Will the parking on Zach Curlin be expanded?
  - o No because it is owned by MLGW
- Will open it up and expand that lot present in that area now
- 19 Senators were in favor to move the garden for parking
- <u>8 senators for making the parking if garden moved and the parking lot remained</u> priority
- Is there a priority lot that we can exchange it for?
- Where to move it?
  - o Move it to the park campus
  - o Would make a good statement for the University
- Why don't we make the parking lot general first and then make it priority?
- A location is possible on the other side of campus but its not the best place for it to grow
- The garden will be replaced absolutely if it is paved over
- Find the author of the petition because it seems very one sided

#### Committee Reports:

- **Student Services** Hugh working on Rec Center Bill--- Rec Center Hours, group fitness classes. Drafted a survey to send out to students.
  - o Want law students and grad students to be able to go to the rec
  - o Why aren't soccer games on the South Campus field Senator Alex Craft
  - o Pertain to renovations of South Campus
- Student Development: Compete to Complete Senator Payton Naifeh
  - o Seats for advisors:
  - o Still gives a voice to the students
  - o SETE not possible to require for all students
  - o Courtney Blanchard suggested that you have to fill out a survey before you register to advise
    - Payton was told that they are not on the same page on that

- Took a survey of the students and students had nothing negative to say
- No one said anything that was totally negative
- o Compete to Complete
  - Encourages students to go to class and do other activities
  - Dr. Irwin
  - Senators working a table during November 15
- Judicial: Senator Attendance Bill; Proposed Constitutional Changes; Looking into Senate Size
  - Kenny said that his committee is presenting a bill about senator attendance
  - Constitutional committee will present the changes
  - Considering senate size that's smaller
- **Finance:** The committee discussed all the travel requests. The committee made several adjustments to the amount of money students could receive for their travel events.
  - How much money travel wise that we have spent
    - We get 16000 to spend for Undergrad
    - Almost at cap for Graduate travel
    - Had to pull from fall semester before in the Spring
- Environmental- Voted on Stop Sign Bill; Amended and voted on Green Fee bill; Looking into parking garage bill
  - Courtney presented that last committee meeting they discussed both bills they are presenting tonight

- Some people are going to the same conference
- The money also depends on what they are doing at the conference
- The total for these to travel 8415
- How often are people going to be traveling in the Spring?
  - Undergraduates will travel in the spring
  - Graduate students travel in both
- We will give at most 20% of what they are asking
- o Motion to slate these bills together and seconded
- o We can look at the funds in the spring and change the allocation
- o Open the floor to vote
  - All in favor: Everyone voted in favor
- Proposed Changes to the Constitution
  - o Taylor Mayberry presented
  - o Met on Monday to review and update the constitution
    - Changes: all the pronouns changed to his/her
    - Article 1: changed that to 2/3 of Senate Quorum
    - Article 3: clarified to two school weeks or 14 days
    - Article 2: Added section that all senators will be held to a review of conduct
    - Order changed
    - Article V clarified
    - Addition to the description of the Chief justice shall be subject to an end of the term review
    - Elections and Qualifications
      - All associate justices must be here for at least a year
    - Clarified election timeline for the spring
      - It is now specifically detailed with dates and time
    - Section 4 duties of Constitutional review committee
  - o Motion to open the floor and seconded
  - Vote to approve all in favor
- Senator Attendance Bill
  - o Bill described
  - o Current bylaws do not have an attendance policy
  - o 1 unexcused and 3 excused are permitted per semester
  - o Have you considered the election process for new senators?
    - How does an appointing system work?
      - We confirm them in the senate
  - Motion and seconded
  - o As legislative council, we would vote to remove them

- It will by a majority vote of legislative council
- o Article 2 Section 2: 1 unexcused and didn't show up to next meeting
  - 2 unexcused and you're out without vote by leg council
- o Bill will be added to bylaws
- o If you miss two unexcused you are out of senate
- What counts as excused and unexcused
- o How many excuses do I have?
- o In three years, will they understand?
- o They want more details on the bill.
- o Motion to move the bill back to committee and seconded
  - All in favor: 15All opposed: 11No abstentions
- Green Fee Bill
  - o This bill would put in place a cap about how long people will continue to be funded.
  - Bill states that after 2 years of funding they would move to University Funding
  - o At year 3 the green fee will only fund 50%
  - o At year 4 it will need to be moved to university funding
  - Sustainability initiative funded many things including a full-time worker and grad students
  - o Questions
    - Why add additional constraints?
      - A recommendation for the University to take on
      - Want the green fee to go toward new projects what students said
    - How does it work right now?
      - Green fee committee is a combo of faculty and students
      - They are appointed and sent out the proposals
      - Then hear the proposals
    - Will it increase student fees?
      - That was not brought up
      - University Is going to try to keep it cheap
    - So, are you in constant contact?
      - Courtney met with Dan Bureau and every project will be notified
    - Some senators are concerned.
    - At year 4 would it go to the University?
      - It would still go to the green fee
    - Motion to open the floor to vote Seconded
    - Motion to move back to committee
      - Approved: 22
      - None Against
      - 1 abstention
- Carpenter Stop Sign Bill
  - o Want a stop sign at the intersection of North tiger paw and west tiger paw
  - o Motion to open the floor for voting
  - o All in favor: Passed
  - o None abstaining or voting against

  - o Talked about getting furniture for the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the main building
  - o Got a comment box outside their SGA office
  - o Working on computer lab times
  - o Mac lab can be used when not used for class purposes
