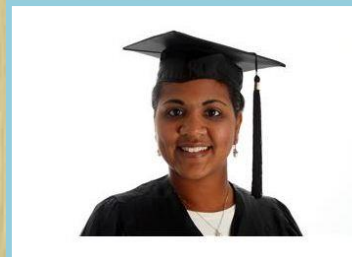

- In return, participants must work for DCS for 18 to 24 months (depending upon the amount of funding they receive) when they graduate.
