PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Bridging the gap between an educational venue and the professional world is important in order to prepare students for the workforce after graduation. Exposure to a wide range of professionals in the field is essential to this goal. We support the professional development of our students by bringing in guest artists, connecting students with internships, paying for our students to attend the South Eastern Theatre Conference (SETC), Unified Professional Theatre Auditions (UPTA), United States Institute for Theatre Technology (USITT), American College Dance Association (ACDA) and other professional audition opportunities, funding a student run production and a New York City senior showcase.

AUDITIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

All BFA programs require an entrance audition and interview. Students who apply by Dec. 1 are automatically considered for academic scholarship. Performance scholarships are available for students who complete their in-person or recorded audition/interview by the last scholarship date found on the web at memphis.edu/theatre.
