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Turning the System On

- 1. Press the Display On button.
- 2. The Desktop button is automatically selected at your convenience.
- 3. The projector warm up cycle will be completed in 3-4 minutes.



Using a Laptop with the System

- 1. Connect the laptop to the laptop cable provided.
- 2. Select either the Laptop 1 or Laptop 2 input.
- 3. For all other inputs, make sure the device is powered on and press the appropriate input button.

Mute Display

- 1. Press Video Mute to blackout the screen at any time.
- Press Video Mute again to restore the image.
 Note: You can control volume using the volume control knob and the Mute button.

Turning off the System

1. Press the **Display Off** button when you are finished.
