MATH 2110 as co-requisite will facilitate modeling with partial differential equations, which is introduced at end of semester.
  - Biom 4410 - Biomedical Engineering Practicum
    - Credit Hours, Description, Repeatability, Add 6000, 7000, or 8000 level course
    - Students may now earn up to 3 total credits for internship experiences (Crosslisted with Mech 4397)
    - Students may earn up to 3 total credits for internship experiences. Previously students were allowed only 1 credit during fall/spring semesters for 10-20 hours of work per week and 2 credits during summer semester if working >20 hours. Allowing variable credit of 1-3 credits adds options for students participating in a full-time Co-op program (3 credits) during any semester, or those working >20 hours (2 credits) during any semester.
  - Biom 4760 - Biomed Engr Design Principles
    - Add/Delete Prerequisite
    - Add BIOM 3010 as a prerequisite for BIOM 4760
    - We are adding BIOM 3010 as a pre-requisite for BIOM 4760 Biomed Engr Design Principles. Due to changes in pre-requisites for BIOM 3710 (existing prerequisite for BIOM 4760), BIOM 3010 needs to be added to ensure students have knowledge/skills in biomedical measurements

before taking BIOM 4760. (Previously, BIOM 3010 was required for BIOM 3710, thus BIOM 3010 was implicitly a pre-requisite.)
