weeks of classes. If books are not picked up within said time-frame, the reservation will be removed,
and books will be made available to other eligible student veterans. Access codes for additional
material are NOT provided by the Textbooks for Tiger Veterans.

RETURNS

You have one week from the end of finals to return your borrowed books. If you change your schedule contact us immediately. If you drop your class, return your book ASAP. Return books to The University of Memphis Veterans and Military Student Services Department University Center Suite 222 Memphis, TN 38152. It is your responsibility to return books in a timely manner. We will typically make every effort to notify you of the late return. We will place a HOLD on your account until all assigned textbooks are returned. Your failure to adhere to the return policy will also lead to a suspension from Tiger Veteran Library privileges.

REPLACEMENT

A. Book Condition

The borrower must make every effort to keep the book in the condition that it was given to them. The following is prohibited:

- 1. Rips, tears, cuts, burns, holes, crinkles, wrinkles or other assaults committed against pages, cover, or book jacket.
- 2. Breaking of previously unbroken bindings.
- 3. Folding of the pages or tearing pages out.
- 4. Excessive highlighting, underlining, or writing of notes, even if the notes are erased before return.

As a University of Memphis student, you are solely responsible for any damage to the textbooks you receive. If textbooks are lost, stolen or damaged in any way, you are responsible for replacing them with books in comparable or better condition.____
