

Costumes

Participants will wear a traditional regional costume. Costumes will be judged on the basis of originality, suitability (cultural relevance), and the oral presentation of no more than five minutes during which the students explain their costume. This presentation will be done in English. Homemade costumes are preferred.

All students will sign up for the order in which they will present their costume. Each student will bring a judging form, the top part of which they have filled out, and will give this to the judge before presenting. The judge will use the form to judge the students.

Judging Criteria: Style, Flair, Attractiveness (50%), Cultural Relevance (25%), and Oral Presentation (25%)

WHO MAY COMPETE: Foreign language students, native/heritage speakers, and speakers of cognate languages are welcome to participate in this event.

LIMITS: No limits on number of entries.
