

Crafts

Students will submit an original craft (other than posters), which might take various forms: models, collections, etc. Content, creativity/originality and cultural relevance are the major criteria for judging. The judges will also be trying to decide whether the craft has real learning value for the competitor(s).

Each craft must include a 3x5 card with the following information: “Category: Crafts”, title of craft, language, school, names of competitors (maximum of two competitors per craft), and name of teacher. Crafts should not exceed an area 2 feet by 3 feet, since space will be limited.

PLEASE NOTE:

Crafts that have won prizes in previous years (even if it was in a different category) may not be re-submitted.

Judging Criteria: Intellectual Content (40%), Creativity/Originality (40%), and Cultural Relevance (20%)

WHO MAY COMPETE: Foreign language students, native and heritage speakers, and speakers of cognate languages are welcome to participate in this event.

LIMITS: Maximum of two entries per class and two students per craft.
