The Department of World Languages and Literatures at the University of Memphis will offer funds to World Language majors enrolled in a University of Memphis study abroad program. Specifically, the department offers to purchase the student's airline ticket to the study abroad program through the University of Memphis travel office (Travelennium). Once approved, students must inform the department of their travel dates and agree to the itinerary provided by Travelennium. Students accept any responsibility or cost for changes to their itinerary. Students will also complete additional paperwork (W-9 form) provided by the department. Students must be citizens or permanent residents of the United States. Preference will be given to applicants who have achieved Junior standing prior to the study abroad experience and who have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00.
